

Second Exam Period Regulations

Registration: 27 May - 20 July 2018 through student intranet account

Period: 10- 21 September 2018

Exam: comprehensive

Courses: nearly all; exceptions will be decided by Departments and Schools

Eligible: all students for all courses they failed (F) during the Fall and Spring Semester of an academic year.

Fee: 65 Euro per course/exam

Grading Format: The final numeric mark of the initial F will have a 40% weight on the new final numeric mark after the second exam. The numeric mark of the second exam will thus have a weight of 60%.

Example 1:

Initial Grade F = 30 (final numeric mark)

Numeric Mark of second exam = 80 *results in:* $30 \cdot 40\% + 80 \cdot 60\% = 12 + 48 = 60$ (D-).

Example 2

Initial Grade F = 0 (final numeric mark)

Numeric Mark of second exam = 90 *results in:* $0 \cdot 40\% + 90 \cdot 60\% = 0 + 54 = 54$ (F).

Example 3

Initial Grade F = 59 (final numeric mark)

Numeric Mark of second exam = 100 *results in:* $59 \cdot 40\% + 100 \cdot 60\% = 24 + 60 = 84$ (B).

Prerequisites:

- If a student fails (F) a course A which is a prerequisite for a course B, s/he could register for the course B during the next semester of the same academic year, assuming that s/he has achieved an overall final

- Numeric mark of 40 in course A.

- The student can be re/examined for both courses A and B during the September Second Exam period
